

## RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the Schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reasons.
4. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £2.00 per competitor, to offset costs. All money will be returned only upon receipt of an S.A.E.
5. Please read all rules for Pony Club Dressage/Dengie in the 2011/2012 Pony Club Dressage Rule Book or on the pony Club web site [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org). A copy of the Rule Book will be held with the Secretary on the day of the competition.
6. Any objection should be made in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £10.00. After due consideration of the objection, the judge's decision is final.
7. No entries will be refunded unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event.
8. Securely fastened hard hats must be worn at all times by everyone when mounted. Hats should be tagged and must conform to PAS 015 1998, EN 1384 1996, BS EN1384 1997 with BSI kite mark, SNELL E2001, AS/NZS 3838 1998 or AS/NZS 3838 2003. Members should bring non-tagged hats to the Secretary when collecting their number. Dark blue or black hats only please.
9. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in a class.
10. Horses or ponies must be over four years old on the day of the competition.
11. No galloping anywhere on the showground, riders must only walk their horses/ponies in the car park. **No lungeing.**
12. Dogs must be on leads at all times.

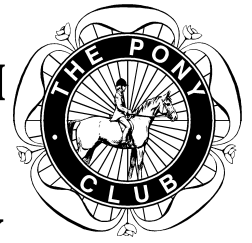

**Section A** – Open to riders 12 years and under (on the day)  
Riders not to have been place 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> in any Dressage Test  
**Section B** – Open to all ages  
**No rider to have competed at P.C Novice Area level or above in either section**  
ANY RIDER COMPETING IN CLASSES 1 & 2 MAY NOT COMPETE IN ANY OTHER CLASS, THIS IS TO EASE PARKING CONGESTION.
- CLASS 3 P.C. NOVICE EVENTING TEST 2006**
- CLASS 4 P.C. NOVICE DRESSAGE TEST 2009  
DENGIE NOVICE QUALIFIER**  
Open to individual Pony Club Members, but excluding any combination of horse/pony and rider that have represented their Branch at Open **or Intermediate** Area qualifiers for The Pony Club Dressage Championships or any Rider who has competed at The Pony Club Open **or Intermediate** Dressage Championships (This does not include any other classes held in conjunction with Area Qualifiers). **Riders** must not have won any BD (or DI) points or competed at BD (or DI) **Novice** level or above.  
**Horses** may be graded British Dressage Novice or below.
- CLASS 5 P.C. NOVICE DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIP TEST 2012**
- CLASS 6 P.C. INTERMEDIATE DRESSAGE TEST 2009  
DENGIE OPEN QUALIFIER.**  
Open to all PC members. Horses which have competed at Advanced Medium level or above during the current year are not eligible. This includes 'Hors Concours' entries.
- Classes 1, 3 and 5 will be held in the outdoor arena**  
**Classes 2, 4 and 6 will be held in the indoor arena**
